Joseph: A Nashville Tribute to the Prophet

Released by Deseret Book in June of 2005, this album about The Restoration has become one of the most popular albums in LDS culture.

Trek: A Nashville Tribute to the Pioneers

Released by Deseret Book in May of 2007, this album is a tribute to that great part of American History when 70,000 people trekked west to find peace and religious freedom in the American West. This music has become a soundtrack for hundreds of Stake Trek events over the years.

The Work: A Nashville Tribute to the Missionaries

Released in June of 2011, this album has become a favorite of future missionaries, current missionaries and return missionaries all over the world. PERFORMANCE HIGHLIGHTS

In 20 years (2005 – 2025), The *Nashville Tribute Band* has performed more than 1,500 shows all over the United States, Australia, China, Canada and Great Britain. The *Nashville Tribute Band* is forever active in assisting area and local church leadership (Area Presidencies, Stake Presidencies, Mission Presidents and Public Relations) to organize events that bring LDS members, full-time missionaries and members of other faiths together to celebrate faith and to foster conviction through music and spoken word.

2024 - NTB continues performances at Regional YSA Conferences in Idaho, Georgia, North Carolina, New Mexico, Illinois and California.

October, 2008 – The *Nashville Tribute Band* was invited by the Joseph Smith Junior & Emma Hale Smith Family direct descendants to travel to Australia and play concerts for a large number of Joseph & Emma’s direct posterity who have lived in Australia since the 1870’s.

In 2015 and 2016 NTB has done a number of shows with iconic entertainer Marie Osmond. The last show we did with Marie had more than 22,000 in attendance and 32 different Christian faiths came together and we raised money to fill 18 food banks in the greater Boise area.

August, 16, 2015 - The first time the Presidency of the Mission Training Center in Provo, Utah invited the Nashville Tribute Band to perform for more than 2,500 missionaries at the MTC. This continues to be our favorite place to perform.

New Years Eve – The *Nashville Tribute Band* has been invited by the Church to headline New Years Eve on Temple Square six times. First in the Assembly Hall, several times in the Tabernacle on Temple Square and once in the Conference Center.

We continue to work with local, regional and worldwide leaders of the Church to help build the kingdom wherever we can help.
